

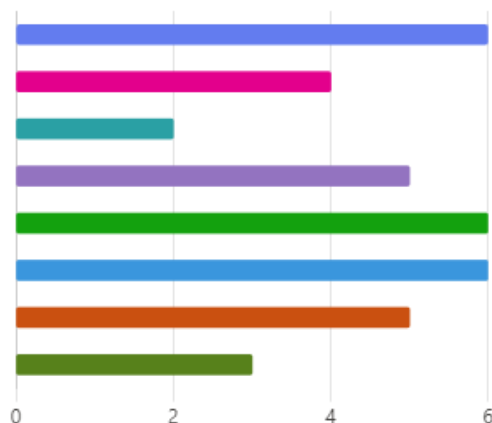
St Lewis' Catholic Primary School RE and Catholic Life Survey: November 2024

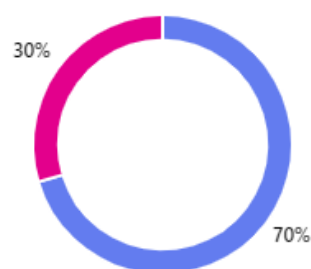
Thank you to everyone who took time to respond.

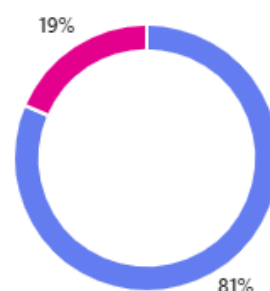
My child is happy at this school

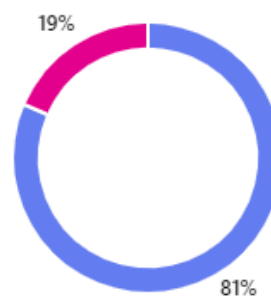
My child feels safe at this school

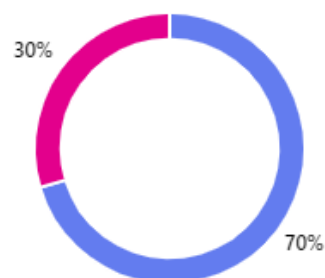
This school enables my child to behave respectfully

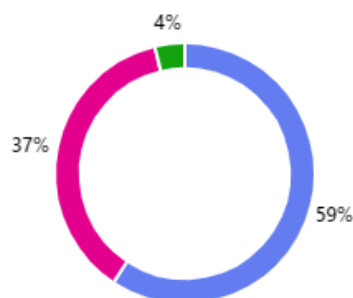
This school is a supportive and joyful community

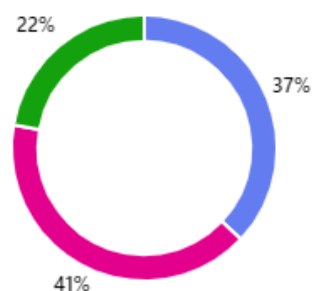
Staff at this school are positive role models for my child

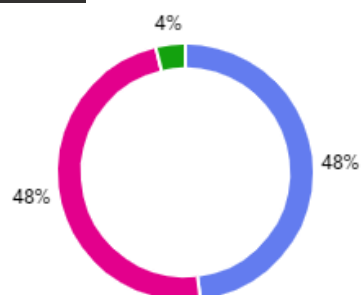
The school works well with the local parish

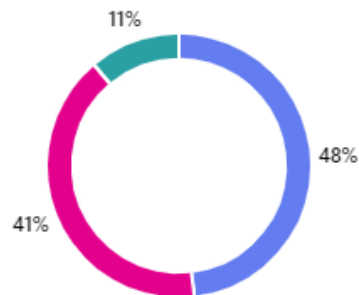
I understand the school's Catholic mission and I am supportive of it

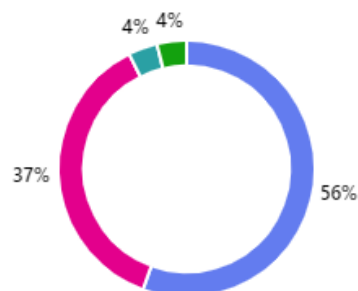
The school supports me in my role as the first educator of my child

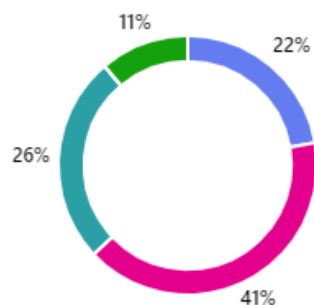
My child enjoys learning in Religious Education lessons

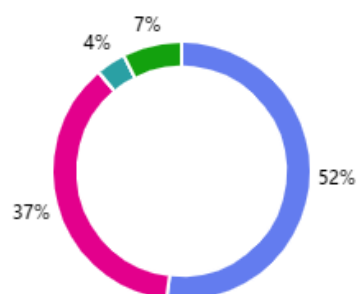
I know how well my child is doing in Religious Education and how to improve

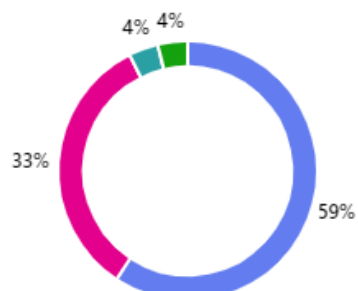
The school supports my child's spiritual and moral development

School comments and response to this feedback:

- As a Catholic school, our faith provides our core purpose and our school Mission Statement is an expression of how we, at St Lewis' live our faith. The Mission Statement underpins all policy and decision making.
- The School Mission Statement will be the driving force behind our long-term strategic plan, which will be shared with parents shortly. As part of this plan we will set out how we want to work closely in partnership with parents and carers, as the first educators of the children in our school, so that together we can ensure the best possible start to your child's Catholic education.
- This year, we have introduced the new Religious Education Directory across the whole school, through the introduction of a new curriculum. This is an exciting development and will further improve provision to support children's learning in Religious Education. As part of introducing this new curriculum, we plan to offer an information session for parents and carers, in addition to information that we are populating on the school website, so that parents and carers have a good understanding of what is being taught.
- Children's progress in Religious Education is shared at Parents' Evening and in your child's end of year report.
- Over the year, we make sure that children are given regular opportunities to celebrate Mass at Church and will continue to work with Fr Gordon and the parish to maintain a strong partnership. The new curriculum for Religious Education provides a renewed opportunity to build opportunities for Father Gordon and parishioners to support children in their learning also.
- In November, a new Prayer and Liturgy Directory was launched for all Catholic schools and we are currently planning how this will be implemented at St Lewis' to further develop provision for Prayer and Liturgy, which is central to our daily life in school. As outlined above for the new Religious Education Directory, we plan to offer an information session for parents and carers, in addition to information that we are populating on the school website, so that parents and carers have a good understanding of our provision for prayer and liturgy at St Lewis' to support children's spiritual and moral development.
