At St Lewis Catholic Primary School, it is very important for us to support all children within the classroom.

Some children may find literacy difficult and as a school we have created a whole school system to support all children.

Here are some examples of tools we are using to adapt lessons:

We chunk information to make information easier for children to understand.

We encourage independence using visual timetables.

We give children time to process information.

We use retrieval activities to assess the children's learning and what vocabulary the children already know and always show new vocabulary to the children including their meaning.

Using our scheme Pathways for Literacy our texts are inspiring and relevant to motivate the children.

We always scaffold and chunk instructions where needed.

We always make sure children feel heard and ask what they find helpful to use to support them.

Coloured overlays are used to support some children with reading.

Standing desks are provided for children who find writing sitting down for long periods of time difficult.

Vocabulary grids are provided to support with ideas.

Careful use of varied groupings enables high quality conversation and sharing of ideas.
