

Homework

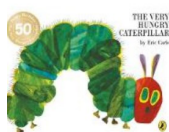

"Everyone is a reader...



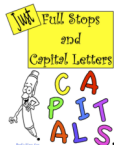
Some just haven't found their favorite book yet."

This term we will be learning all about plants.

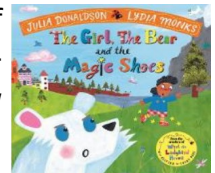
We will be looking at the structure of a plant and labelling it including roots stem and flower.
