Thanks to those parents who joined us for our first PTA meeting today after school.

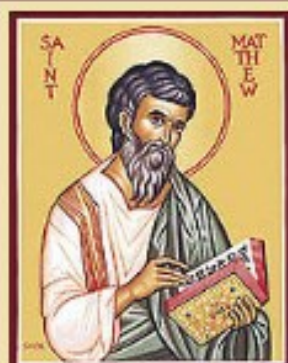
A date has been set for the first event which will be a Halloween Disco for the children on Friday 17th October.

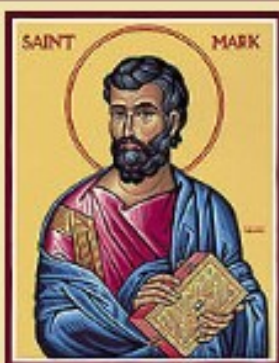

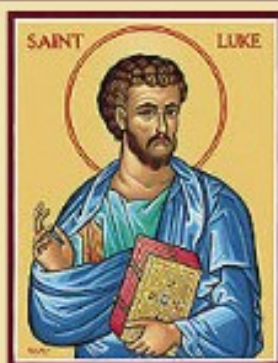

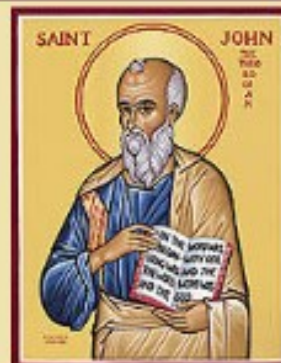
