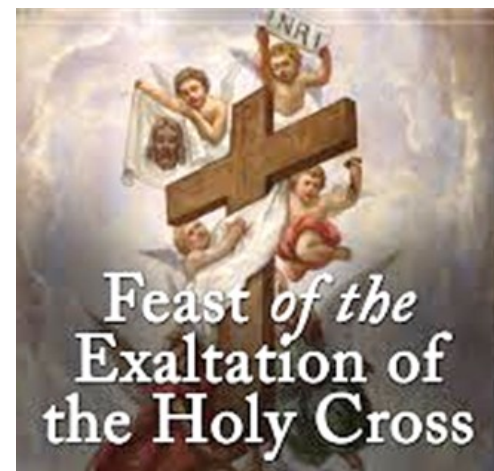

The Feast of the Holy Cross, Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, or Feast of the Cross, commemorates the True Cross. On 13 September, 335, the Constantinian Basilica over the Holy Sepulchre was consecrated in Jerusalem. The day after the church's consecration, the relic of the cross was shown ("exalted") the first time to the people for veneration. Later, the feast was also associated with the commemoration of the recovery of the Holy Cross by Emperor Heraclius on 13 September 628.

2nd Collection This weekend: Catholic Education Services

A second collection for Catholic Education Service (CES) will take place this weekend. The CES represent the Bishops' national education policy in relation to the 2,169 schools, colleges, academies and universities for which the Church is responsible in England and Wales.

They negotiate with the UK and Welsh Governments and other national bodies in order to safeguard and promote Catholic education.

They also offer a Catholic contribution to English and Welsh educational debates, seeking to ensure the principles of Catholic teaching are reflected in all aspects of national education policy.

2nd Collection Next Weekend: Evangelii Gaudium Sunday

Evangelii Gaudium Sunday, formerly known as Home Mission Sunday. This year, the Church has been celebrating a significant anniversary. It's 1,700 years since the Council of Nicaea. This great gathering of Bishops from around the Church began the work to formulate the creed we proclaim Sunday by Sunday. It is the content of this creed that is our mission, so that we may know and love God in this life, in order to be happy with him forever in the next. The creed begins with a profound proclamation, "I believe..." This is the theme for *Evangelii Gaudium Sunday* 2025.
