John the Baptist was a man whose life was driven by one mission: to point people to Jesus. We may think today of all of those people in our lives who have inspired us, strengthened our faith and pointed us to Jesus.

In today's Gospel, while Jesus is praying we hear that the heavens opened. We get an image of the Trinity as God's voice is heard and a dove descends. These are all signs to show us that Jesus

is the Beloved Son of God, and that this is the beginning of his mission.
