Our whole school attendance this week was 98.51%. Well done everyone—keep it up!

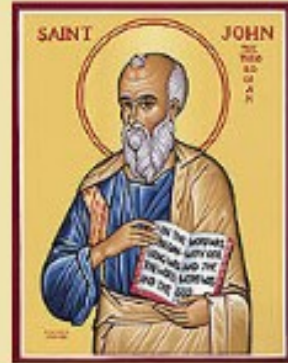
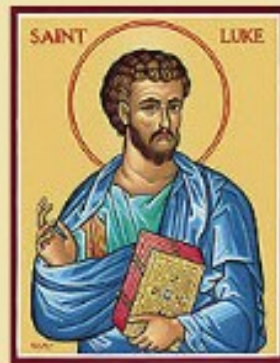
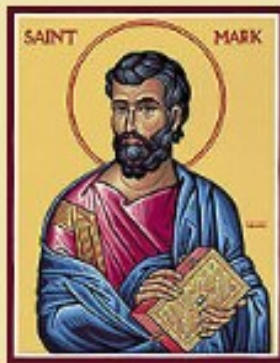
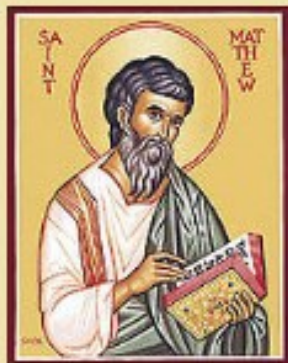
